NEW DISCOVERIES!

At All Engelhard, we've been at this for a few decades now, logging and classifying ingots, and estimating and refining data based on logged examples. In the early years, we were coming up with new discoveries weekly, but as word spread and worldwide market information filled our inbox, and subsequently our Definitive Pages, the discoveries slowed to the point where we haven't seen a new Engelhard discovery in over a year. That is, until this past week! And boy are these exciting... to us anyway!

Firstly, our good friend Yas in the UK came across an Engelhard London Silver 1 Kilo with a large "L" prefix (above left photo), the first "L" prefix we have seen in all of our years of logging. We have just added this L 2197 ingot to our Definitive Pages and are always curious if more of the same will come forward with this entry now visible to collectors worldwide.

Secondly, this Engelhard 25 T.oz ingot s/n 0000011 (bottom bar in right photo) was submitted by Casey M. and while the stampings and font are familiar, the mould size is wider and flatter, much like the Canadian 32.150 oz mould. This is also the first of this variety we have seen, with a 7 digit serial number like we have seen in early 10 T.oz and 100 T.oz examples. This ingot has also been added to our Definitive Pages as a unique 6th series entry.

As always, we are grateful to our collector community for your continued contributions to All Engelhard, and we're excited to see what comes across the wires Next!!!
